- Competition is governed by the rules and regulations of the SOBHD.
- Judges decision is FINAL. Only the competition organizer is authorized to communicate with the judge.
- First to enter last to dance.
- Age groups will be determined according to the number of entries received.
- We reserve the right to combine or cancel any event due to lack of participants. If event is cancelled, competitors will be notified prior to the day before the competition.
- **Dances will be danced in reverse order, beginning with nationals first.**
- **Premier 7 and Under 12 will dance cut steps, Fling (4), Sword (2&1), Sean Truibhas (3&1)**
- Venue is indoor with theater seating. Restrooms available, dressing rooms available for costume changes. Venue does not allow food or drinks, water is allowed. Star Hall is a historic building and is listed on Utah's historic listing, built in 1905 and renovated in 2008.
- Dancers must present valid 2022 SDUSA Registration Card - No card - NO DANCE.
- SDUSA Registration Cards will remain with the competition organizer throughout the competition, and will be available at time of awards.
- Dancers must be ready and appear when called or forfeit the chance to dance in that event
- Medals will be awarded in each event. DANCERS MUST BE IN COSTUME TO RECEIVE AWARDS. If there are three dancers or less in any event, medals will be awarded at the judges discretion. A trophy will be awarded to the highest aggregate point winner in each age group. No trophy for primary.

CHOREOGRAPHY

THEME: Moab's Amazing Night Skies/Moab Star Hall

As a welcome back to our choreography, let's celebrate Scottish Highland Dance in the form of the beautiful stars! Our theme this year has two possibilities, the amazing star gazing within our national and state parks in Moab. Or a nod to the early settler's of Moab who built the historic Star Hall in 1905. Please visit <https://www.discovermoab.com/moab-night-skies/> and watch the wonderful video on the night skies of Moab for your inspiration choreography.

- Choreography competition is open to registered dancers.
- Content should consist primarily of movements from Highland, National, Hornpipe, and Jig books.
- A maximum of five minute time limit, this includes entrance, exit of competitors, setting up and removal of props. The choreographed dance will be limited to 3 minutes. Performances will be timed, disqualification for exceeding the time limit.
- Props may be used during performance, either static or non-static, but live animals are not permitted.
- REGISTRATION must include a list of ALL team members for group below.
- Dancers entering solo or group choreography must compete in the regular competition.
- Dancers may only compete in one group with a minimum of 2 dancers and a maximum of 5.
- Music must have a Celtic theme and Celtic costume. Also, music must be submitted to the organizer no later than October 1st. Music must be in digital format: mp3/mp4. Email music to chelleaug@gmail.com.
- Teams should consist of one school only. More than one school, in which case, the teacher, choreography must abide by the three month teaching/judging rule set by SOBHD.
